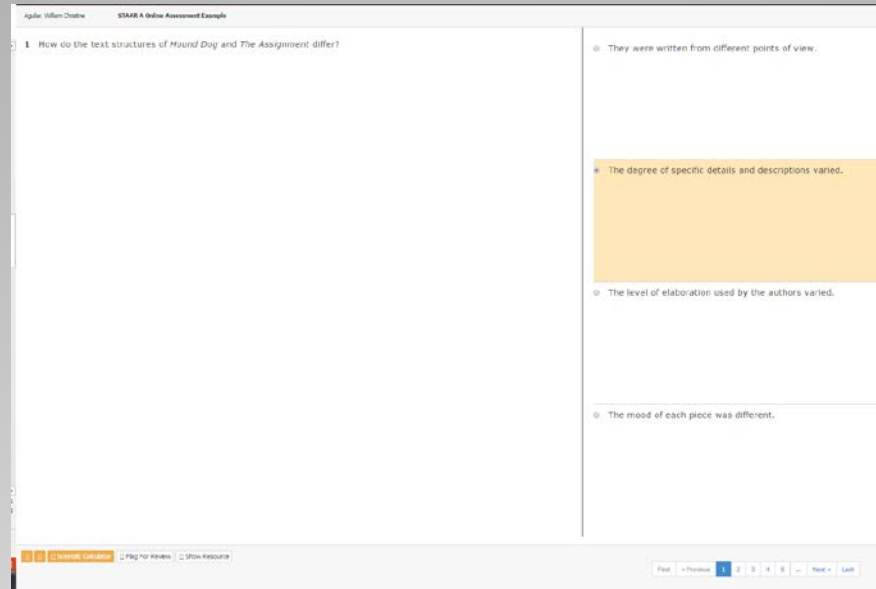

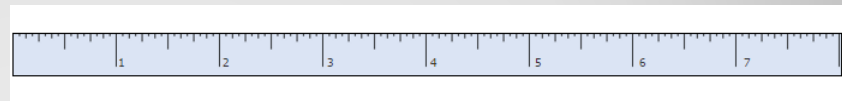
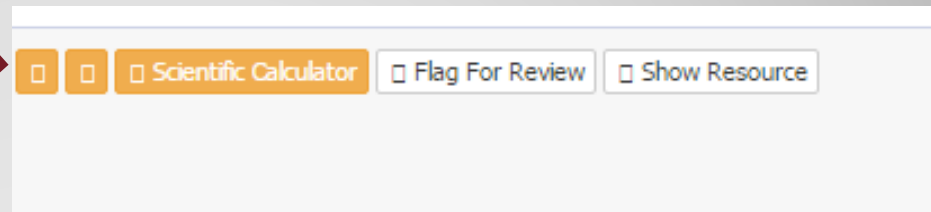
If you want to change an answer, you can always go back and select any question during your test by selecting that question on the left. You'll also notice a 'previous' button so that you can go back to your last question.



Taking an Online Test

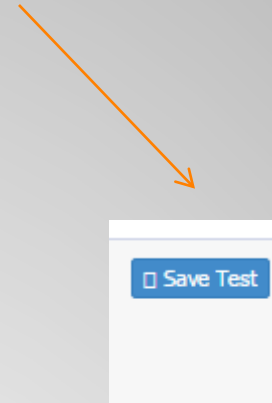
Below is an image of the tools you can turn on for assessments.

- Or show the resource associated with the question. (this includes passages).



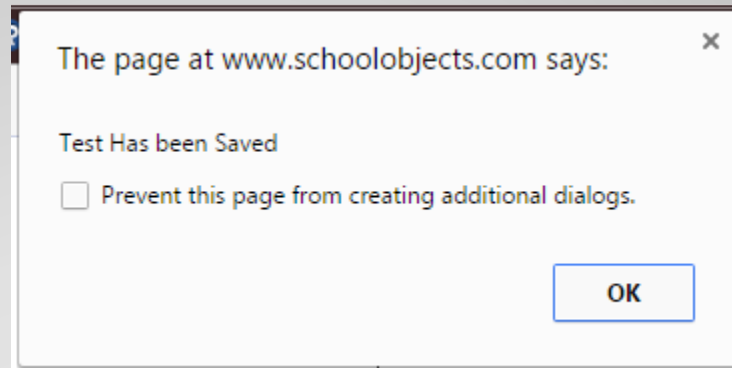
Taking an Online Test
